FOL IS TEXT OF SOV DRAFT RES INTRODUCED INTO SC NOV 20 PM:

"THE SECURITY COUNCIL,

EXPRESSING CONCERN AT LACK OF PROGRESS TOWARDS POLITICAL
SETTLEMENT IN MIDDLE EAST AND AT INCREASED TENSION IN AREA,

NOTING THAT THERE HAVE EVEN BEEN VIOLATIONS OF CEASE-FIRE
CALLED FOR BY SECURITY COUNCIL IN ITS RESOLUTIONS 233 OF
6 JUNE, 234 OF 7 JUNE, 235 OF 9 JUNE AND 236 OF 12 JUNE 1967,
WHICH WAS REGARDED AS FIRST STEP TOWARDS ACHIEVEMENT OF JUST
PEACE IN AREA AND MUST BE STRENGTHENED BY OTHER APPROPRIATE
MEASURES,

EMPHASIZING URGENT NECESSITY OF RESTORING PEACE AND ESTABLISHING NORMAL CONDITIONS IN MIDDLE EAST,

1. DECLARES THAT PEACE AND FINAL SOLUTIONS TO THIS PROBLEM CAN BE ACHIEVED WITHIN FRAMEWORK OF CHARTER OF UNITED NATIONS;

2. URGES THAT FOLLOWING STEPS SHOULD BE TAKEN:

(A) PARTIES TO CONFLICT SHOULD IMMEDIATELY WITHDRAW THEIR FORCES TO POSITIONS THEY HELD BEFORE 5 JUNE 1967 IN KEEPING WITH PRINCIPLE THAT SEIZURE OF TERRITORY BY MEANS OF WAR IS INADMISSIBLE;

(B) ALL STATES MEMBERS OF UNITED NATIONS IN AREA SHOULD IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZE THAT EACH HAS RIGHT TO EXIST AS AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL STATE AND TO LIVE IN PEACE AND SECURITY AND SHOULD IMMEDIATELY RENOUNCE ALL CLAIMS AND DESIST FROM ALL ACTS INCONSISTENT WITH FOREGOING;

3. DEEMS IT NECESSARY IN THIS CONNEXION TO CONTINUE ITS CONSIDERATION OF SITUATION IN MIDDLE EAST, WORKING DIRECTLY WITH PARTIES CONCERNED AND MAKING USE OF PRESENCE OF UNITED NATIONS, WITH A VIEW TO ACHIEVING AN APPROPRIATE AND JUST SOLUTION OF ALL ASPECTS OF PROBLEM ON BASIS OF FOLLOWING PRINCIPLES:

(A) THE USE OR THREAT OF FORCE IN RELATIONS BETWEEN STATES IS INCOMPATIBLE WITH CHARTER OF UNITED NATIONS;

(B) EVERY STATE MUST RESPECT THE POLITICAL INDEPENDENCE AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF ALL OTHER STATES IN AREA;

(C) THERE MUST BE JUST SETTLEMENT QUESTION OF PALESTINE REFUGEES;

(D) INNOCENT PASSAGE THROUGH INTERNATIONAL WATERWAYS IN AREA IN ACCORDANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS;

4. CONSIDERS THAT, IN KEEPING WITH STEPS TO BE TAKEN ALONG LINES INDICATED ABOVE, ALL STATES IN AREA SHOULD PUT AN END TO STATE OF BELLIGERENCY, TAKE MEASURES TO LIMIT USELESS AND DESTRUCTIVE ARMS RACE, AND DISCHARGE OBLIGATIONS ASSUMED BY THEM UNDER THE CHARTER OF UNITED NATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS."
