Enclosures A and B list the roll call votes at the 5th Emergency Special Session of the U.N. General Assembly, which convened June 17 to consider the Middle East situation and adjourned "temporarily" July 20.

On July 4 the Assembly voted on and failed to adopt any of the four resolutions introduced on the main issue. The votes on these resolutions and two amendments are recorded in Enclosure A. A fifth resolution, submitted by the United States, was not pressed to the vote.

The Assembly did adopt two resolutions July 4: one on humanitarian issues and one on Jerusalem. A second resolution on Jerusalem was adopted July 14, and on July 21 the Assembly adopted the resolution adjourning the Assembly. The votes on these four resolutions are listed in Enclosure B.

The following summary of the issues voted upon is to be used in conjunction with the enclosures. The items are listed in the order in which the votes were taken.

Cuban Amendment: would have amended the Yugoslav draft resolution (see below) by adding an operative paragraph condemning "the aggression committed by the State of Israel against Jordan, Syria and the United Arab Republic, and its principal instigator, the imperialist Government of the United States of America." Defeated July 4 by 20-78, with 22 abstentions.

Albanian Amendment: would have amended the Yugoslav draft resolution (see below) by adding an operative paragraph strongly condemning "Israel for its aggression against the United Arab Republic, the Syrian Arab Republic and Jordan." Defeated July 4 by 32-66, with 22 abstentions.

Yugoslav Draft Resolution (also referred to as the Yugoslav-Indian, 18-nation or non-aligned draft resolution): (1) called for immediate Israeli withdrawal to positions held prior to June 5; (2) requested the UN Secretary General (SYG) to ensure compliance and to secure, with the assistance of the U.N. Truce Supervision Organization, strict observance of the General Armistice Agreements between Israel and the Arab countries; (3) requested the SYG to designate a personal representative to assist in securing compliance and to be in contact with the parties concerned; (4) called on all states "to render every assistance to the SYG in the implementation of the present resolution in accordance with the Charter of the UN"; (5) requested the SYG to report urgently to the Assembly and to the Security Council on compliance; (6) requested that the Security Council "consider all aspects of the situation in the Middle East and seek peaceful ways and means for the solution of all problems -- legal, political, and humanitarian -- through appropriate channels, guided by the principles of the Charter of the UN, in particular those contained in Articles 2 and 33." Defeated July 4 by 53-46, with 20 abstentions.

Soviet Draft Resolution:

Preamble: noted that Israel had committed premeditated aggression, had continued to conduct offensive military operations and seized additional territory in contravention of Security Council ceasefire resolutions, and by continuing its occupation had failed to halt its aggression and defied the UN and all peace-loving states. Also termed "unacceptable and unlawful Israel's territorial claims on the Arab states, which prevent the restoration of peace in the area." Defeated July 4 by 36-57, with 24 abstentions.

Operative Paragraph 1: vigorously condemned "Israel's aggressive activities and the continuing occupation by Israel of part of the territory of the United Arab Republic, Syria and Jordan, which constitutes an act of recognized aggression." Defeated July 4 by 36-57, with 23 abstentions.

Operative Paragraph 2: demanded immediate and unconditional Israeli withdrawal "to positions behind the armistice lines" and Israeli respect for "the status of the demilitarized zones." Defeated July 4 by 45-48, with 22 abstentions.

Operative Paragraph 3: demanded "that Israel should make good in full and within the shortest possible period of time all the damage inflicted by its aggression on the United Arab Republic, Syria and Jordan and on their nationals, and should return to them all seized property and other material assets." Defeated July 4 by 34-54, with 28 abstentions.

Operative Paragraph 4: appealed to the Security Council to take "immediate effective measures in order to eliminate all consequences of the aggression committed by Israel." Defeated July 4 by 36-54, with 26 abstentions.

Albanian Draft Resolution: similar to the Soviet draft except for the addition of a paragraph firmly condemning the US and UK "for their incitement, aid and direct participation in this aggression and because they continue to support the aggression and the annexationist claims of Israel." Defeated July 4 by 22-71, with 27 abstentions.

Latin American Draft Resolution: (1) urgently requested (a) Israel to withdraw from all territories occupied as a result of the conflict and (b) the parties to end the state of belligerency, to endeavor to establish conditions of coexistence based on good neighborliness, and to have recourse in all cases to the peaceful settlement procedures indicated in the UN Charter; (2) reaffirmed that no stable international order could be based on the threat or use of force and declared that the validity of occupation or acquisition of territory by such means should not be recognized; (3) requested the Security Council "to continue examining the situation in the Middle East with a sense of urgency, working directly with the parties and relying on the presence of the United Nations to (a) carry out the provisions of operative paragraph 1(a) above; (b) guarantee freedom of transit on the international waterways in the region; (c) achieve an appropriate and full solution of the problem of the refugees and guarantee the territorial inviolability and political independence of the States of the region, through measures including the establishment of demilitarized zones"; (4) reaffirmed "as in earlier recommendations, the desirability of establishing an international regime for the city of Jerusalem, to be considered by the General Assembly at its twenty-second session." Defeated July 4 by 57-43, with 20 abstentions.

Humanitarian Resolution: (1) welcomed the Security Council resolution of June 14 calling on Israel to ensure the safety, welfare and security of the civilian inhabitants of areas where military operations had taken place and to facilitate the return of those inhabitants who had fled, and recommending that all parties respect the 1949 Geneva conventions on treatment of POWs and civilians; (2) noted with gratification the work of UNICEF, the International Committee of the Red Cross, the League of Red Cross Societies and other voluntary organizations; (3) endorsed efforts by the U.N. Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA) "to provide humanitarian assistance, as far as practicable, on an emergency basis and as a temporary measure," to the "new" refugees; (4) appealed to all Governments to make special contributions to UNRWA as well as to the other inter-governmental

and non-governmental organizations concerned; (5) requested the SYG, in consultation with UNRWA, to report urgently on the needs of both the "old" and "new" refugees. Adopted July 4 by 116-0, with 2 abstentions.

Jerusalem Resolution of July 4: "The General Assembly, deeply concerned at the situation prevailing in Jerusalem as a result of the measures taken by Israel to change the status of the city, (1) considers that these measures are invalid; (2) calls upon Israel to rescind all measures already taken and to desist forthwith from taking any action which would alter the status of Jerusalem; (3) requests the SYG to report to the General Assembly and to the Security Council on the situation and on the implementation of the present resolution not later than one week from its adoption." Adopted July 4 by 99-9, with 20 abstentions.

Jerusalem Resolution of July 14: (1) deplored the failure of Israel to implement the July 4 resolution; (2) reiterated the call to Israel to rescind all measures, etc. (para 2 of the July 4 resolution); and (3) requested the SYG to report to the Security Council and to the General Assembly on the situation and on the implementation of the resolution. Adopted July 14 by 99-0, with 18 abstentions.

Adjournment Resolution: "The General Assembly, having considered the grave situation in the Middle East, considering that the Security Council continues to be seized of the problem, bearing in mind the resolutions adopted and proposals considered during its fifth emergency special session, (1) requests the SYG to forward the records of the fifth emergency special session to the Security Council in order to facilitate the resumption by the Council, as a matter of urgency, of its consideration of the tense situation in the Middle East; (2) decides to adjourn the fifth emergency special session temporarily and to authorize the President of the General Assembly to reconvene the session as and when necessary." First operative paragraph adopted July 21 by 62-27, with 27 abstentions; resolution as a whole adopted July 21 by 63-26, with 27 abstentions.
