1. COORDINATING SUBCOMMITTEE APPROVED WITH FEW CHANGES ALMOST ALL PROCEDURAL ARTICLES OF DRAFT PROTOCOL OF AMENDMENT TO CHARTER PREPARED BY SECRETARIAT, ADDING PREAMBLE OF THREE PARAGRAPHS.

2. COMMITTEE A SPENT MOST OF DAY DEBATING PROCEDURAL QUESTION WHETHER FURTHER SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL STANDARDS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED. VENEZUELA, CHILE, URUGUAY AND COSTA RICA HAD WHOLE SERIES OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

THEY WISHED TO INTRODUCE TO SOCIAL STANDARDS, SUBSTANCE OF WHICH HAD ALREADY BEEN REJECTED BY IA-ECOSOC AND COAS IN WASHINGTON, CHAIRMAN III SPECIAL IAC FINALLY RULED THAT COMMITTEE SHOULD NOT CONSIDER FURTHER SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS.

COMMITTEE APPROVED WITHOUT CHANGE ARTICLE 14 OF ECONOMIC STANDARDS AND ARTICLE 1, PARAGRAPHS A, B, C, AND D OF SOCIAL STANDARDS. ARTICLE 13 OF ECONOMIC STANDARDS APPROVED WITH ADDITION OF WORD "ADEQUATE" BEFORE "PRIORITY".
