SUBJECT: DAILY REPORT NO. 5 ON THIRD SPECIAL IAC DEVELOPMENTS, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 20

1. COORDINATING SUBCOMMITTEE APPROVED WITH FEV CMANGES ALMOST ALL PROCEDURAL ARTICLES OF DRAFT PROTOCOL OF AMENDMENT TO CHARTER PREPARED BY SECRETARIAT, ADDING PREAMBLE OF THREE PARAGRAPHS.
2. COMMITTEE A SPENT MOST OF DAY DEBATING PROCEDURAL QUESTION WHETHER FURTHER SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS TO ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL STANDARDS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED. VENEZUELA, CHILE, URUGUAY AND COSTA RICA HAD WHOLE SERIES OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

THEY WISMED TO INTRODUCE TO SOCIAL STANDARDS, SUBSTANCE OF WHICH HAD ALREADY BEEN REJECTED BY IA-ECOSOC AND COAS IN WASHINGTON. CHAIRMAN III SPECIAL IAC FINALLY RULED THAT COMMITTEE SMOULD NOT CONSIDER FURTHER SUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS.

COMMITTEE APPROVED WITHOUT CHANGE ARTICLE 14. OF ECONOMIC STANDARDS AND ARTICLE 1, PARAGRAPHS As B, C, AND D OF SOCIAL STANDARDS. ARTICLE 13 OF ECONOMIC STANDARDS APPROVED WITH ADDITION OF WORD "ADEQUATE" BEFORE "PRIORITY".

A. CHAPTER 17 PANAMA DRAFT RE IA JURIDICAL COMMITTEE, APPROVED ALL ARTICLES WITH MINOR MODIFICATION OF ARTICLE 1 AND INCREASE IN NUMBER OF MEMBERS FROM 9 TO 11。
B. CHAPTER 18 RE HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION. APPROVED WITH MINOR MODIFICATION.

C。 CHAPTER 19 RE GENERAL SECRETARIAT. APPROVED ALL ARTICLES EXCEPT AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 3 POSTPONED.
ARTICLE 11 APPROVED WITH NEW TEXT PROPOSED BY SOLOMBIA AS FOLLOWS: "THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT SHALL APPOINT, WITH APPROVAL OF CORRESPONDING COUNCILS, AN EXECUTIVE SECRETARY FOR ECONOMIC AND GOCIAL AFFAIRS AND AN EXFCUTIVE SECRETARY FOR EIUCATION. SCINECE, AND CULTURE, WHICH WILL ALSO BE SECRETARIEG OF THE CORRESPONDING COUNCILS."
