that Francisco J. Chaves

has been appointed Honorary Consul of the Dominican Republic at Bayamon, Puerto Rico,

I do hereby recognize him, as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers, and privileges, as are accorded to Honorary Consuls by the law of Nations and by the laws of the United States.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done, at the City of Washington, this nineteenth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred and ninety-third.
