DEPCIRTEL 851

1. ALL POINTS COVERED REFTEL DISCUSSED WITH FONMIN GOMEZ TODAY. HE EXPRESSED GENERAL AGREEMENT WITH DEPT'S VIEWS AND TACTICS. HE WAS PARTICULARLY ENTHUSIASTIC IN ENDORSING TWO-STAGE CONFERENCE PROPOSAL.
2. ON RESTRUCTURING AND DECENTRALIZATION, FONMIN FELT BRAZILIAN PROPOSAL, "AS HE UNDERSTOOD IT," SEEMED GOOD IDEA BASED ON ONLY SUPERFICIAL CONSIDERATION. HE OFFERED NO COMMENT ON U.S. VIEW RE WISDOM OF REVIVING CULTURAL COUNCIL AS BODY CO-EQUAL WITH ECOSOC AND COUNCIL OF JURISTS. FORMIN STRONGLY FAVORS REDUCING SECGEN'S TERM OF OFFICE, MENTIONING FOUR YEARS.
3. ON IDEA OF PERMANENT IAPF, FORMIN EXPRESSED GENERAL AGREEMENT US POSITION BUT REMARKED THERE WOULD BE STRONG OPPOSITION FOR SOME OARS.
4. GOMEZ WILL DEPART FOR MEETING CAP FONMINS IN PANAMA ON NOVEMBER 13, GOING ON TO RIO NOVEMBER 16.
