Chapter 400; 3 FAM 350

Effective August 28, 1966, the Standardized Regulations (Government Civilians, Foreign Areas) are revised as follows:

Sec. 411 f.

- Deleted

Sec. 430 a.

- In line 6 "and 411 f" is deleted and "and 440" is substituted.

Sec. 440

- The entire section is re-titled and replaced as follows:

Amount of Usual Household Expenses

The following table shows the amount of annual usual household expenses that must be borne personally by a principal representative according to class of mission for Chiefs of Mission and grade for other officers.

Sec. 445 A new section 445 is added as follows:

445 Limitation on Household Servants

The head of agency is required to place a limitation on the total number of household servants that may be employed at Government expense in the official residence of a principal representative of that agency consistent with the needs of such representative.

Sec. 450 is revised to read as follows:

Within allotted funds, and subject to the provisions of Section 445, an official residence allotment may be charged, or reimbursement made therefrom the principal representatives, for the official residence expenses (See Sec. 411 c) described in sections 451, 452, and 453 that exceed on an annual basis the applicable amount of usual household expenses specified in section 440.

Sec. 451 a is revised to read as follows:

Wages and maintenance of household servants.

The purpose of these amendments is to (1) control the expenditure of Government funds for ORE; and (2) provide one amount of annual usual expense to be borne personally by a principal representative in operating an official residence. Previously, the regulations provided an amount of usual expenses only for the wages and maintenance of household servants. (Former Sec. 440) Now, the annual usual expense amount represents the principal representative's personal share of all the expenses of operating and maintaining an official residence.

Also, effective August 28, 1966, 3 FAM 350 is revised as follows:

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350 Official Residence Expenses

A new section 356 is added as follows:

356 Limitation on Household Servants (State only)

In accordance with provisions of section 445 of the Standardized Regulations (Government Civilians, Foreign Areas), the appropriate regional bureau and IO shall determine the limitation to be placed on the total number of household servants to be employed in official residences of principal representatives in their respective areas.

The purpose of the FAM revision is to delegate authority to the geographic regional bureaus and the Bureau of International Organization Affairs to limit the number of servants employed in the official residences of principal representatives in their respective areas.

It will be appreciated if each Embassy will distribute copies of this airgram to representatives of other agencies at the post.

Upon receipt of TL:SR-150 and the printed amendment to 3 FAM 350 this airgram may be cancelled.
