The Department would like to remind each Post of President Johnson's request for a thirty percent (30%) reduction of accidents and injuries in his program "Mission Safety-70". In announcing the plan to reduce job deaths and injuries to the Federal Government's 2.5 million employees, the President termed it "another front in our War on Waste...waste of human resources, productive skills and money."

The total number of injuries sustained in the State Department rose over 8% during the calendar year 1965. And the total number of fatalities increased in 1965, over 1964.

It appears that our accident record has worsened, but it is believed that, if each supervisor recognizes his responsibility and takes positive action to reduce accidents and injuries during the next quarter, the Department may improve its injury experience during 1966.

Each Post is requested to review its safety program and to ensure that an all-out effort is being made to accomplish President Johnson's objective in "Mission Safety-70".
