1. Customs Folicy Council Resolution No. 676, published in the D lario Oficial of June 9, 1969 grants exemption of import duty on polyethylene. A free English translation of the text follows:

2. The Customs Policy Council, acting under authority vested in it by Item "c" of Art. 22 of Lew No. 3244 of August 14, 1957, RESOLVES:

3. Article 1 - Article 3 of Resolution No. 574 of August 29, 1968 of this Council shall be altered to read as follows:

"Article 3 - To grant exemption of import duty, in accordance with Art. 4 of Law No. 3244 of 8/14/57 amended by Art. 7 of Decree Law No. 63 of 11/21/66, on low density polyathylene, classified under subttem 39-02-012.02 of the customs tariff, to those importers who qualify to the Foreign Trade Department of the Bank of Brazil S.A. (CACRI) by submitting proof of purchase of the national product in the proposition of 100% of the quantity to be imported.

Paragraph 1 - Proportion mentioned in this article may be altered at any time if necessary in order to guarantee purchase of national production.

Paragraph 2 - Customs clearance with the benefit foreseen in this Article shall be authorized upon presentation of import document or license issued specifically for this purpose up to May 16, 1970.

4. Article 2 - Customs clearance shall be guaranteed in accordance with Art. 3 of Resolution No. 574 of August 29, 1968, of this Council, to merchandise covered by import document already issued by CACEX.

5. Article 3 - This Resolution shall become effective fifteen days after publication in the Diario Oficial.
