84-43-001	Centrifugal turbine of intermittent flux, conventional basket type with daily production capacity of approximately 400 to 1200 sixty kilo sacks of sugar, coupled directly to electric motor, complete, hand controlled (10 to 25 HP, 600 to 1200 RPM, 5 tons) and semi-automatic control (75 to 100 HP, 500 to 1500 RPM, 3.5 tons) for separation of sugar crystals in molasses originating from sugar industry vacuor cookers.
