FOR COMMERCE

1. Customs Policy Council Resolution No. 662, published in the Diário Oficial of May 9, 1969 establishes a minimum value on acyclic alcohols as follows:
2. The Customs Policy Council, acting under authority vested in it by items "c" and "d" of Art. 22 of Law No. 3244 of August 14, 1957, RESOLVES:
3. Article 1 - To establish, in accordance with Art. 9 and for the purposes of Art. 5 of Law 3244-57, a minimum value of US\$320.00 CIF per ton for octyl (octanol-octensanol) and iso-octyl alcohols, classified, respectively, under sub-items 29-04-017 and 29-04-026 of the Customs Tariff.
4. Article 2 - To grant exemption from import duty, in accordance with Art. 4 of Law 3244 of August 14, 1957, amended by Art. 7 of Decree Law No. 63 of November 21, 1966, on octyl and iso-octyl alcohols, to those importers who qualify with the Foreign Trade Department of the Bank of Brazil (CACEX) submitting proof of acquisition of national product in the proportion of 1 ton per 1.8 tons imported.
5. Article 3 - This Resolution shall become effective fifteen days after publication in the Diário Oficial.
