Dear Marshall:

Regarding your note of September 10, 1970 I have written to Washington for the address of the new shipping companies which plan to carry lumber from Amazonia. As soon as the information arrives I will forward it to you.

Regarding parrots and pets citizens can take a reasonable number (brazilian law allows only two of each kind for each individual). However, they should have the required injections which are available from the Secção de Proteção Animal of the Secretaria de Agricultura and a certificate to the effect that the parrot or pet has been inoculated. Fulfilling this requirement is the responsibility of the person concerned.

Thanks for the information on the turkeys. I will send you some money in a few days.
