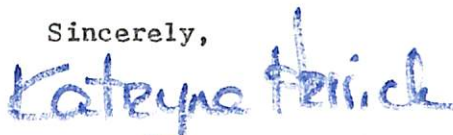

BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON

BRAZILIAN STUDENT SEMINAR GROUP

IN THE UNITED STATES JANUARY 24 - FEBRUARY 28, 1969

Participants in the Educational Travel Program, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs, U. S. Department of State. Seven student leaders from São Paulo will visit the United States from January 24 through February 28, 1969. The students were selected from a seminar on "International Organizations and Forces for Change" arranged by the United States Information Service in São Paulo. The seminar was structured around the organization, development and functioning of international organizations. The topics were covered with the highest degree of depth possible by utilizing, whenever available, professors from the local universities who had extensive knowledge of the areas discussed. The students were required to submit a paper on one of the topics and the seven students were chosen on the basis of the excellence of their work.

The participants are:

1. Mr. Marcio Prieto. Mr. Prieto is a 21 year old student of civil engineering. He is Vice-president of Grémio Politécnico and he has a fair knowledge of Spanish and English.
2. Mr. Francisco Manoel Pereira Franca Valente. Mr. Pereira is a 25 year old fourth year law student and Vice-president of the Student Association, Catholic University, Faculty of Law. He has travelled in Portugal and he speaks English, French and Spanish.
3. Mr. Antonio Caetano Prado. Mr. Caetano is a 20 year old student of law at the University of São Paulo. He is a member of the Centro Academico XI de Agosto and his outside interest include theatre, literature and the cinema. Besides Portuguese, Mr. Caetano speaks English and French.

4. Mr. Anibal da Cunha Maccheroni. Mr. da Cunha is 23 years old and a fifth year law student. He speaks French, Spanish and Italian and his outside interests include literature, sociology and the arts.
5. Mr. Iraia Hilgenberg Prestes Mattar. Mr. Hilgenberg is a 22 year old law student and a member of the Centro Academico XI de Agosto. He has travelled in Argentina, Uruguay and Paraguay and speaks English, Italian and French.
6. Miss Lea Roccato. Miss Roccato is a 22 year old student of law specializing in public and private international law. She speaks English, French, Italian and Spanish and her outside interests include literature, anthropology, music, cinema and sports.
7. Miss Lenita Nicoletti. Miss Nicoletti is 23 years old and a student of the social sciences. She speaks English, Spanish and Italian and her outside interests include theatre, cinema and literature.
