Dear Mr. Watson:

The following information may be of interest to the President:

A confidential source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised on May 22, 1965, that Cesar Cruz Mordan, Press Secretary for Juan Bosch, and Carmen Bosch, wife of Juan Bosch, deposed Dominican President, were in conversation. Cruz referred to a recent article appearing in the "New York Herald Tribune" newspaper by Barnard Collier in which it was stated that the United States diplomats had reached an agreement "yesterday" with the Constitutionalist rebels ending the civil war and setting up a legal government and that details had been sent to Washington for final approval.

According to the source, Carmen Bosch several times during the conversation mentioned that "they" (possibly referring to Bosch adherents) would not likely stand on Dominican soil again.

The above information was orally furnished to Mr. Ronald E. Cavalier at the White House International Situation Room on May 22, 1965, by Special Agent Paul F. Shea of this Bureau.
