		Comment: From conversations with several people in Osasco the reporting officer has concluded that people feel the government expelled Father Vautier without good reason. He was well liked by his colleagues at work and by people in the community. He was not as active politically as several of the Brazilian priests. The general impression in Osasco was that he was singled out because he was a foreigner.
