SJBJECT：PROTECTIONIST LEGISLATION IN CONGRESS
1．LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS TO IMPOSE QUOTAS AND／OR AUTHORIZE EGOTIATION OF BILATERAL QUOTA AGREEMENTS CONTINUE TO BE INTRO－ DUCED，PARTICULARLY IN THE SENATE。MOST TROUBLESOME PROPOSALS ARE THOSE BEFORE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE FOR ACTION FOLLOWING HEARINGS OCTOBER $18-20$ ．THESE INCLUDE NEW RESTRICTIONS ON ALL TEXTILES AND APPAREL，STEEL，MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS，MINK FURS， LEAD AND ZINC，WATCHES AND WATCH MOVEMENTS，GROUNDFISH BLOCKS AND FILLETS，BASEBALL GLOVES AND MITTS，STRAWBERRIES，HONEY，AND STAINLESS STEEL FLATWARE。IN ADDITION，PRESENT RESTRICTIONS ON PETROLEUM AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS，DAIRY PRODUCTS，AND COTTON TEXTILES WOULD BE MADE MORE RESTRICTIVE RESTRICTIONS ON COTTON TEXTILES WOULD，FOR EXAMPLE，BE INTRODUCED ON COUNTRIES

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PRESENTLY FREE OF QUOTA SUCH AS THE EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND CANADA. AN AOMNIBUS QUOTA BILL TO COVER ALL SUCH PROPOSALS AND PROVIDE FOR UNILATERAL QUOTAS OR BILATERALLY NEGOTIATED QUOTAS WILL PROBABLY BE INTRODUCED IN NEXT FEW DAYS, AND ADMINISTRATION IS INCREASINGLY CONCERNED THAT REAL DANGER EXISTS. FOLLOWING IS SUMMARY OF TOTAL U.S. IMPORTS IN 1966 COVERED BY SPECIFIC PROPOSALS MENTIONED ABOVE: TOTAL COVERAGE, EXCLUDING COTTON TEXTILES AND TRADE PRESENTLY UNDER QUOTA, WOULD BE 2.9 BILLION DOLLARS. INCLUDING COTTON TEXTILES, COUERAGE RISES TO 3.4 BILLION, AND INCLUDING OTHER TRADE CURRENTLY UNDER QUOTA, COVERAGE WOULD GO TO 5. $\square$ BILLION DOLLARS.
