DOMINICAN SITUATION

A source who has furnished reliable information in the past provided the following information to our San Juan, Puerto Rico, Office:

On May 20, 1965, Diego Bordas, a former member of the cabinet of deposed Dominican President Juan Bosch and who is currently serving as an advisor to Bosch in Puerto Rico, attempted to contact one Bobby Baker at telephone number EM 2-1817. Bordas did not speak with Baker at this time and was advised Baker would not return until after 5 p.m. It was suggested Bordas should try contacting Baker at his office number, CO 5-7003. Bordas was unable to contact Baker at the latter number and he requested that Baker be asked to return his call.

In the current Washington Metropolitan Area Telephone Directory, telephone number CO 5-7003 is listed for Robert G. Baker, lawyer, 2000 P Street, NW. The same Directory lists telephone number 362-1817 for Robert G. Baker, 5115 Van Ness, NW.
