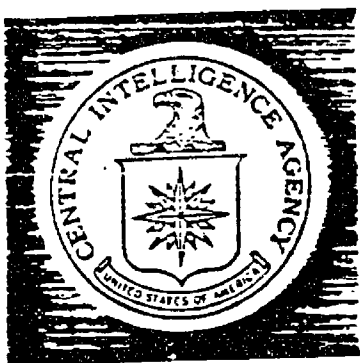

ious state of the urban terrorist movement in Brazil. All of the groups have suffered from the loss of skilled leaders and from internal dissension about how to meet the imminable regression by the authorities.

men from all the military services and from several civil police agencies are engaged in the manhunt. They have killed two men identified as members of the MR-3 and captured at least one more.

The dissension in the VPR apparently was responsible for Lamarca's departure from it and his joining the MR-3 last March.
