

* **US/Soviet Exchange Activity.** The Council is preparing a handbook for Americans participating in exchanges with the Soviet Union. It also provides briefings for Americans intending to visit the Soviet Union. In general, the Council's approach is to promote the widest possible contacts and flow of information between Americans and citizens of the Soviet Union. It believes that the possibilities for mutual disarmament and other important agreements with the U.S.S.R. will be enhanced to the degree that it becomes a more open and pluralistic society.

* **Resource Center and Networking.** The Council is an important resource center, frequently providing materials, files, directories and reference services to a range of people with research needs or specific questions about organizations, different approaches to community peace activity, crisis issues, etc. In serving as a resource center and catalyst of events, the Council also assists in developing a regional network of individuals sharing common values and approaches with respect to issues of war and peace.
