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To those long-suffering people waiting for an Anarchist catalog:

As many of you know, the Libertarian Book Club was supposed to have a new book catalog almost 18 months ago. The reasons for this will not be mentioned here. A Distribution decided to put out a substitute catalog almost a year ago but, again, there were problems. We have decided not to wait any longer. Enclosed is a copy of our wholesale catalog (feel free to share it with your local bookstore) and separate sheets of titles that we only have on a retail basis. The retail part of our business will probably be rapidly changing for a while and a update will be sent in 6-8 weeks to anyone ordering or otherwise contacting us.

Several comments need to be made. First, many prices have gone way up because of foreign currency fluctuations. Because of this, we've temporarily reduced our postage rates. Also, some of you may have noted that A Distribution has changed addresses and now shares an office with the LBC. Despite this, the Book Club and A Distribution are two completely separate organizations. We will honor Book Club member discounts for now (20%), as well as pass on LBC membership dues (\$10) to the LBC, but we are in no way responsible for the upkeep of their membership and mailing lists.

Some things are the same. A Distribution remains a non-profit collective dedicated to distributing a wide range of anarchist and other marginal literature. Any contributions are always welcome. Feel free to send us names of other people who may be interested in getting a catalog.
