What is libertarianism?

According to the I.R.S., "Libertarianism is a political philosophy. In the libertarian view, societies and governments infringe on individual liberties whenever they tax wealth, create penalties for victimless crimes, or otherwise attempt to control or regulate individual conduct which harms or benefits no one except the individual who engaged in it."

According to libertarian spokesman Marshall Fritz, "Libertarianism is self-government. It combines the best of both worlds: the left leg of self-government is tolerance of others. The right leg is responsible economic behavior. The combination of both legs leads to social harmony and material abundance."
