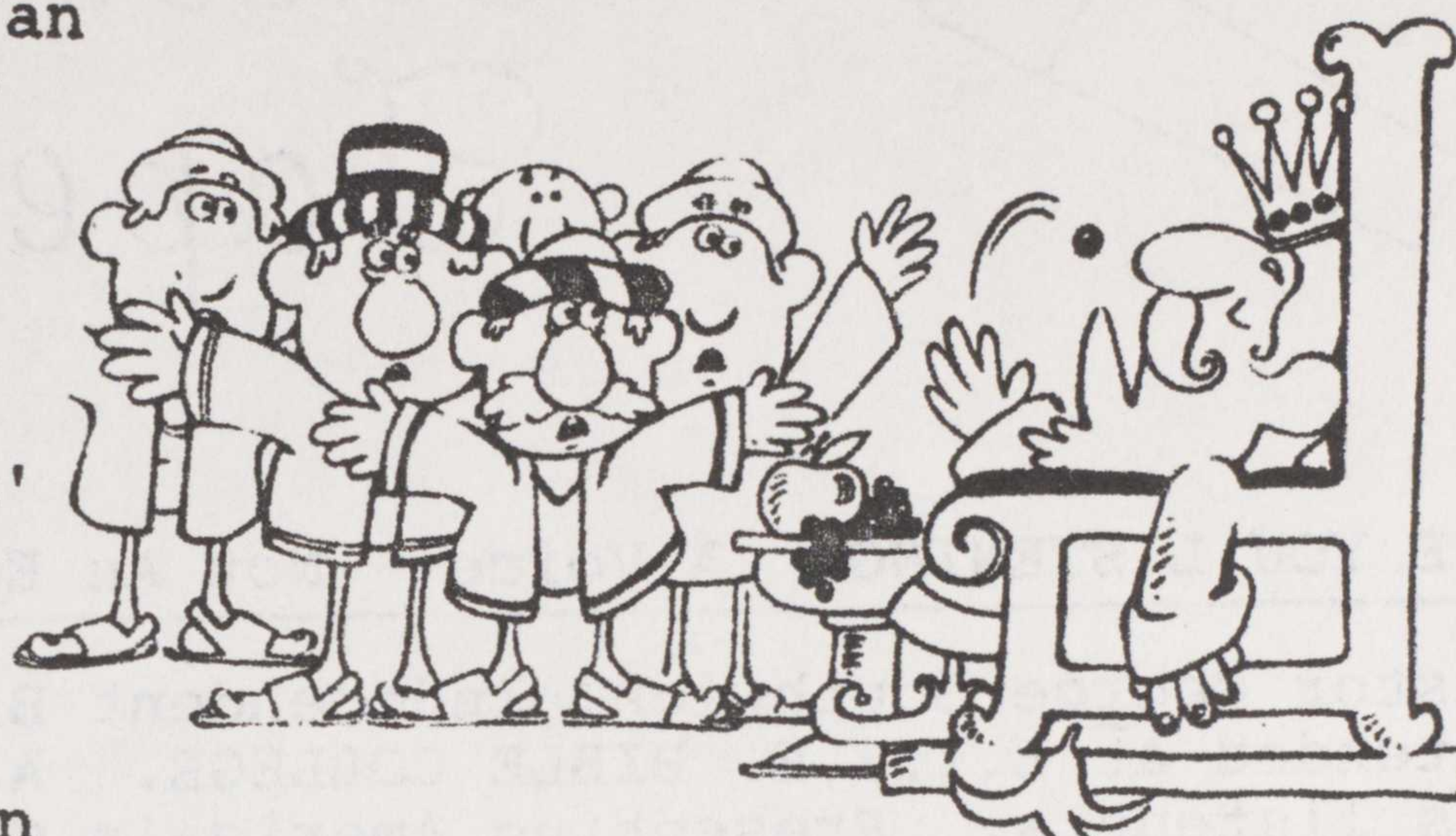


Plato in his solution believed in an intellectual aristocracy as guardians of the people....keeping an unthinking 'democracy' in its place.
