GOD HELP ME TO REMEMBER....That I don't have to argue anybody into believing anything. This is the Holy Spirit's Office work: to "convince the world of sin, and of righteousness and of judgment." John 16:8

George Fox said: "The man who quarrels about religion has no religion to quarrel about."

It is the enemy who wants to dictate what individual Christians must believe and why...If I try to force my conscience upon others I am of another spirit than that of Christ. Paul wrote continually "I beseech you..." Persuasion by the operation of the Holy Spirit is New Testament!

GOD HELP ME TO REMEMBER....When a person disagrees with me, it is no proof of his being more ignorant, stupid, obstinate or deluded than I am...My mission in this world is to be a humble witness, not an arrogant wrangler. Many have become religiously obnoxious in this area of religion. Discussion, talk, etc. is wonderful! Argumentativeness shouting and pounding tables and pronouncing violent anathema's, let them not be once named among you! Name-calling is NOT Christian...

The more the things of which I am bulldogmatic, absolutely certain of, (and maintain it); the greater the evidence of the narrowness of my information and the shallowness of my thinking....

It is my fellow-Christians duty (if he so desires) to doubt my interpretations of Scripture till the Holy Spirit bears witness to his spirit that my conclusions have warrent. Acts 10:17-20

GOD HELP ME TO REMEMBER...In order to show me my own intolerance, fanaticism and arrogance, the Holy Spirit may even withhold a person from seeing a truth to which I am trying to proselyte him!
