Presidential Elections

1. Ministry of Justice released following statement to press November 1: "In order to clarify unauthorized divulgence of declarations attributed to governmental organs regarding the possibility of immediate convocation of indirect elections by the President of the Republic, the Minister of Justice declared that these reports lack foundation. Thus the speculations circulate at the responsibility of those who propagate them."

2. Estado De Sao Paulo ran editorial November 2 calling attention to rumors that President inclined to leave government January 31, 1966. While expressing doubt that President would abandon his duty to revolution simply to give convincing demonstration of his lack of personal ambition, editorial states that if President cannot bring himself to full application of powers of new act then his decision to relieve himself of responsibilities conferred upon him by revolution is legitimate.
