1. BRAZIL VIEWED BY GOG AS MAJOR LA POWER BECAUSE OF ECONOMIC IMPORTANCE, SIZE, POPULATION AND STRENGTH OF ARMED FORCES. GUATEMALANS PROBABLY RATE MEXICO, COLOMBIA AND CHILE AS MORE IMPORTANT LA POLITICAL LEADERS 。 BRAZIL'S DIRECT INFLUENCE ON GUATEMALA MARGINAL, EXCEPT ON COFFEE POLICY AS NOTED BELOW.
A. BECAUSE OF CLOSENESS: US=GOG TIES, GOG ATTITUDE TOWARD BRAZIL WOULD BE EFFECTED SOMEWHAT BUT PROBABLY NOT DECISIVELY BY NATURE US=GOB RELATIONS.
