President Castello Branco signed decree late Saturday, May 30, cancelling mandates 3 Goias state deputies and suspending their political rights and those of 2 Goias judges, 1 journalist and 2 members Governor Mauro Borges State Cabinet, Wilson da Paixao, Secretary of Interior and Justice and Padre Ruy Rodrigues, Secretary of Education.

State deputies affected were Jose Porfirio (PTB Suplente) and Olinto Meirelles (UDN). Porfirio, widely-known peasant leader, believed hiding in native Trombas-Formosa area of state and attempting form guerrilla band. Meirelles, as UDN leader in state assembly, led unsuccessful attempt impeach Mauro Borges and in Borges counter-attack was accused of Communist sympathies. Now generally accepted that General Castro E. Silva's investigating Committee accepted Borges evidence against Meirelles to demonstrate its impartial character.

No report yet received of Governor Borges reaction but decrees follow lines of rumored compromise between Borges and Federal government. Thus, surprisingly short list may indicate end month-long Goias crisis, though fear remains in some quarters that since list did not include many known Communists, it incomplete and will be followed by another.
