Brazilian Communist Parties." The meeting also was described as having confirmed again "the absolute loyalty of both parties to the Moscow Declaration and Statement and the identity of views on current questions of the international communist movement."

COMMENT: From the above press reports, it is clear that the Sino-Soviet ideological conflict was a topic of discussion at the meeting between the two Communist leaders. The Prestes visit to Prague may well be part of a new round of preliminary soundings among leaders of major communist par-
