Comment: The Governor's statements were especially irrelevant and unnecessary, given the occasion and the fact that Ultrafertil is so highly favorable for Brazil. Most of the audience appeared takenaback and embarrassed by the Governor's remarks and gave him only perfunctory applause. Several months ago the Governor 'dropped a lead balloon' in a similar speech referring to American capital before the American Chamber of Commerce. Let us hope this latest example of infelicitous phraseology and ineptness, or else of an ill-conceived attempt to appeal to nationalist sentiment, is a temporary aberration.
