Paper calls for choice that will "liberate the unions from the monstrous embrace of the Labor Ministry, transforming them into autonomous social forces working for the interests of the workers. "If this doesn't occur, paper foresees unions "eventually liberating themselves by their own hand" with "inevitable leftist motivations."

Concludes JORNAL DO BRASIL: "A society that spurns its workers and maintains them under an unjust tutelage is arming the workers against itself."

COMMENT: Re Para 4--Labor Minister Passarinho used the occasion of the April 9 closing ceremonies of the National Confederation of Industrial Workers Congress to reaffirm his previous public statements favouring free trade unions and his "opposition to left and right wing dictatorships."
