SUBJECT: CHANGES IN IBC DIRECTORATE FORECAST

REF: RIO 1150

1. EMBASSY HAS CONFIRMED THAT MINISTER YASSUDA'S RESIGNATION WILL RESULT IN CHANGES IN COFFEE INSTITUTE (IBC). (IT PROBABLE THAT PRESENT IBC PRESIDENT, JAIME MIRANDA, KNOWN AS YASSUDA MAN, WILL LEAVE SOON.) ALTHOUGH PRESS REPORTS THAT FONOFF ASST. SECY GEN FOR ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, RONALDO COSTA, LIKELY TO BECOME NEW IBC PRESIDENT, RELIABLE SOURCES TELL US HE WILL STAY AT FOREIGN MINISTRY. SAME SOURCES CONFIRM THAT NEW IBC DIRECTOR WILL BE CARLOS VIACAVA, PRESENTLY CHIEF OF DELFIM NETO'S ADVISORY STAFF, AND JOAO SATTAMINI NETO, CHIEF IBC'S MILAN OFFICE. SATTAMINI WILL ACCOMPANY COSTA ON FORTHCOMING TRIP TO U.S. AND TO LONDON ICO MEETING.
