New Brazilian Ambassador to Italy.

The Senate approved on July 2, 1964, the nomination of Francisco d'Alamo Lousada as Brazil's new Ambassador in Rome.

The Department is requested to forward a copy of its biographic sheet of May 11, 1949, and a copy of Rio de Janeiro's data sheet of November 24, 1950, to Rome. We request also that Oslo submit to Rome any available complementary data with copies to the Department and this post.

Ambassador Lousada stated recently in São Paulo, where he was reportedly initiating contacts with business leaders, that he will seek to expand Brazil's exports to Italy, principally in terms of coffee, but also of iron ore and meat. These latter commodities, he believes, have potential to surmount coffee as Brazil's chief export.

His wife, Maria de Lourdes d'Alamo, is from a wealthy Rio de Janeiro family. They have two children, Carlos Eduardo and Luis Claudio.

Since departing Bern in 1954, Lousada has served as Ambassador to Guatemala from 1954 to 1956 and as Ambassador to Norway from 1958 to the present.
