Subject: Enforcement of Right to Information legal provisions in the District

Sir,
Rajsamand district is known across the country as a district where the people and the administration have taken a lead in highlighting the need for RTI. Yet, after the coming into effect of the National RTI Act in October 2005, the district is lagging behind in enforcing many of its legal provisions. We draw your attention in particular to the government's suo-moto duty to inform.

Section 4 of the RTI Act places 17 kinds of obligation on every public authority to disseminate information to people without being asked. (copy of the provisions are enclosed.)

Under the RTI Act, P.R. Act & Rules, Rural Development

and Panchayati Raj Guidelines the Government and Panchayats are obligated to have a board in every panchayat with information about sanctioned and executed works under different schemes painted on the board. Rajsamand took the lead in this respect, and this is now being followed in different parts of the country.

However, in Rajsamand itself due to a misplacement of decision these boards were painted over during the Lok Sabha elections, and have not been re-painted or updated ever since.

③ There is very low awareness of RTI obligations amongst officials in the district. There is a need to hold training & orientations & pass a strong message that any violation of the RTI Act will be severely dealt with. There need to be regular reviews of the implementation of the Act in all offices and at all levels. It is only if these minimal steps are taken that we can expect to involve people in ensuring a more transparent and responsive administration. If ~~some~~ some of these steps are seriously implemented, we are confident that Rajsamand could become a model for transparency and accountability. In anticipation of prompt action,

निवेदन यह भी है कि कानून के तहत धारा 4 की सुओ मोटो जानकारी के लिए भी कोई जवाब नहीं दिया गया है। इससे जानकारी लेने में बहुत परेशानी है और यह इस कानून को भावना एवं सरकार को पारदर्शी करने में बाधा उत्पन्न रहा है।

आपसे निवेदन है कि उपरोक्त विषयों पर जल्द कार्यवाही करवाये और हमें न्याय दिलवाने का कष्ट करें।

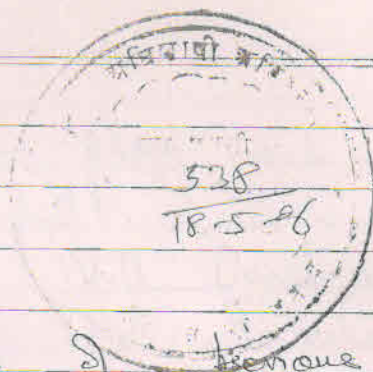
