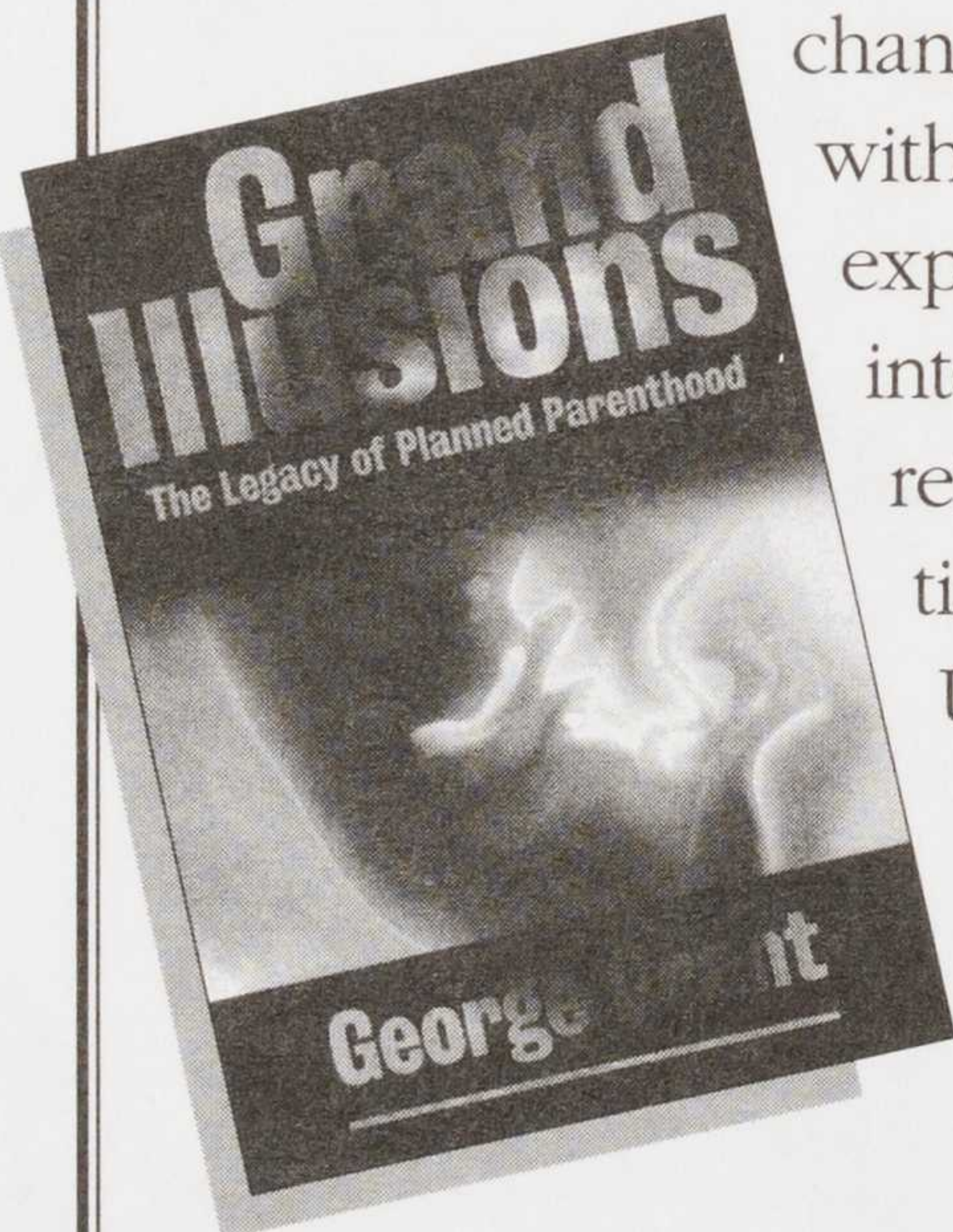


Grand Illusions by George Grant
