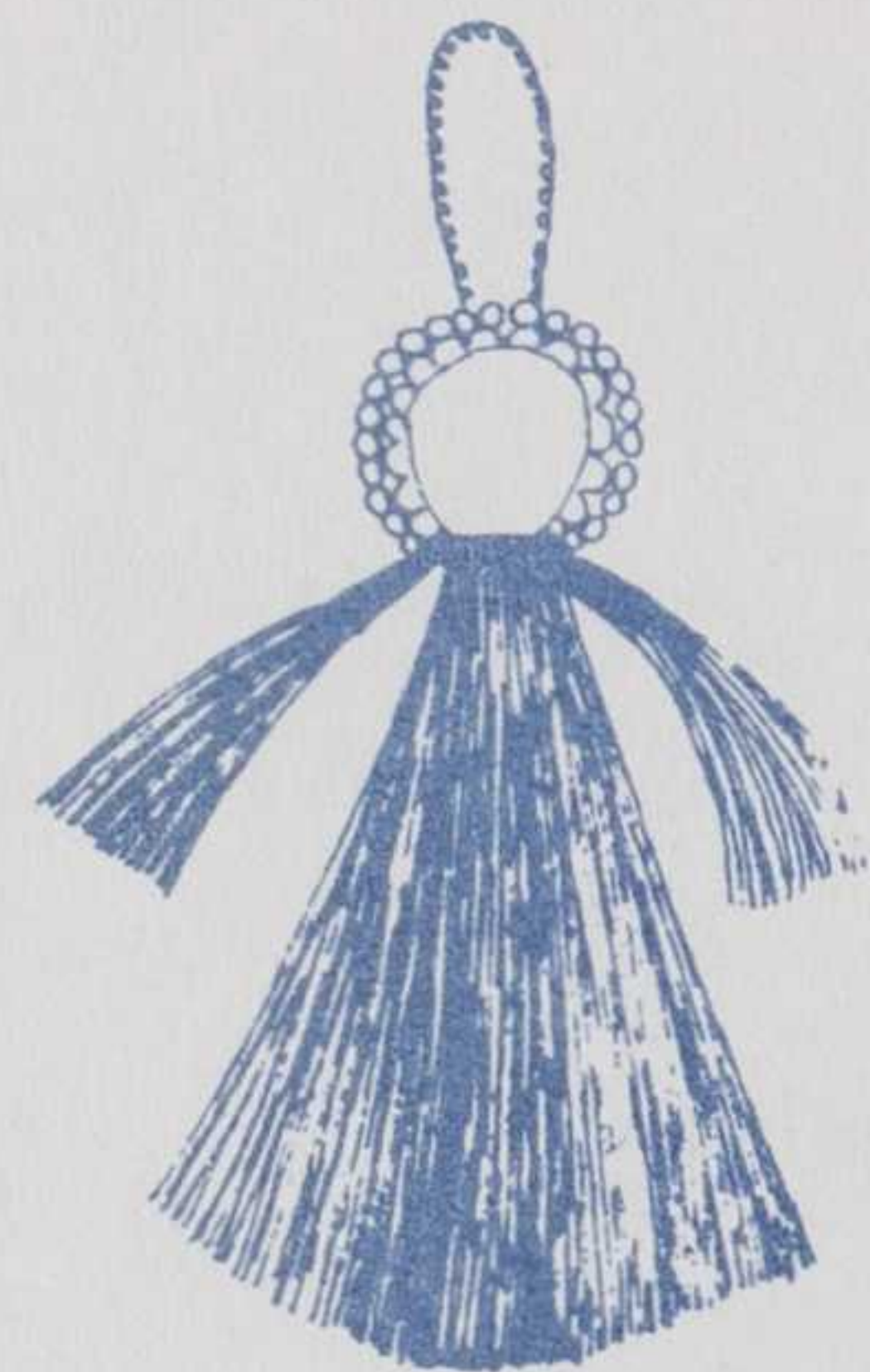


FRIENDS OF THE THIRD WORLD, INC
