Officers who have been enrolled for more than one (1) year without submitting any lessons, should be requested to withdraw and return their course material to the Department, unless there is good reason to believe that the officer will be able to commence work on the course immediately and complete it within a reasonable length of time. Where delay in submission of lessons has been unavoidable, the officer should indicate the circumstances in the "Remarks" section of the Progress Report.

Progress Report forms are being sent under separate cover to those posts which did not receive them in December of 1966. Additional forms will be sent upon request.
