Newspaper Exchange

CHIPS, the Cooperative Highschool Independent Press Syndicate, is a service we provide for independent and underground youth newspapers. Its goal is to let you see copies of papers that other young people are putting out, from which you can reprint articles, get ideas, and find general encouragement.

To participate, just send us 25 to 50 copies of each issue you publish — or fewer, if you can't afford that many. As soon as we get them, we'll send you a packet of papers from other areas.

Organizing Kit

To help young people who are doing organizing, we've put some of our materials together in a Youth Liberation Organizing Kit. It contains four of our pamphlets (including one or two about organizing), five sample student underground papers, three different mini-posters, and two sample copies of *FPS: a magazine of young people's liberation*. It's available from us for \$3. (Our prices are guides. If you are young or on a limited income, send what you can; if you are employed, we hope you can send extra.)

A Youth Liberation Magazine

One of our programs is publishing *FPS*: a magazine of young people's liberation. *FPS* covers all aspects of the youth liberation movement. Regular features include: *FPScope*, a collection of short news items about kids; the CHIPS pages, with reprints of articles from high school underground papers; legal information; student rights news; and book reviews. Each issue also provides in-depth coverage of subjects like student organizing, running away, relationships with your family, school reform, and other youth-related issues.

In December, 1975, *FPS* changed from a monthly schedule to an irregular schedule, so we would have time to publish new pamphlets. subscribers to *FPS* will get these new pamphlets, as they come out, as a part of their subscription. Thus, a 12-issue subscription to *FPS* means you'll get our next 12 publications — some of them being issues of *FPS*, others being pamphlets. A 12-issue subscription costs \$10 for adults, \$6 for people under 18.
