1. FOLLOWING IS EMBASSY TRANSLATION NOTE FROM BRAZILIAN DIRECTORATE CIVIL AVIATION (DAC) INFORMING PANAM OF NON-APPROVAL PANAM'S ANNOUNCED SCHEDULE CHANGES TO ENTER INTO EFFECT NOVEMBER 1. REFUSAL REPORTED RIO REFTEL.

ACTION TAKEN

"I. REFERRING TO THE SCHEDULES PRESENTED BY LETTER 19/71 OF OCTOBER 6, 1971, I INFORM YOU THAT THE SAME CANNOT BE APPROVED SINCE THEY PRESENT IDENTICAL FLIGHT NUMBERS FOR DIFFERENT ITINERATIES AND A FUSING OF FLIGHTS 441/442 AND 515/516 ON THE RIO-SAO LEG.

"II. AS YOUR OFFICE WAS ALREADY INFORMED VERBALLY, THE USE OF DIFFERENT NUMBERS FOR THE SAME FLIGHT IS NOT ALLOWED, AND THE FRACTICE HAS ONLY BEEN TOLERATED FOR REASONS OF GOOD WILL UNTIL YOUR COMPANY COULD TAKE CORRECTIVE MEASURES. IN THE SAME WAY, USING THE SAME NUMBERS FOR DIFFERENT FLIGHTS IS NOT ACCEPTABLE, SIN THIS, AS IN THE OTHER CASE, INVALIDATES THE REASONS FOR NUMBERING FLIGHTS, I.E., TO IDENTIFY AND DEFINE ROUTE TO BE FLOWN AND STOPS.

"III. IN ORDER TO CLARIFY THE ABOVE AND AVOID DIFFICULTIES WITH NEW DOCUMENTS, WE INFORM YOU THAT: A) THE REGULATION OF ANNEX B TO THE FINAL ACT OF CONSULTATION V, WHICH ESTABLISHED THAT RIO AND SAO PAULO WILL BE CONSIDERED AS THE SAME "GATE WAY" SPECIFICALLY REFERS TO CAPACITY OF SERVICES OFFERED AND IN NO WAY AUTHORIZES SPECIAL OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES BETWEEN THE TWO,

B) PAN AMERICAN HAS THE RIGHT TO CHOOSE THE INITIAL AND THE TERMINAL POINTS ON ITS LINE, BE THOSE RIO OR SAO PAULO, AND CAN FREELY OMIT STOPS.
NEVERTHELESS, THERE IS NOTHING WHICH AUTHORIZES THE COMPANY TO FLY ONE SERVICE WITH TWO DIFFERENT NUMBERS (FLIGHTS 441/442 AND 515/516 ON RIO-SAO PAULO LEG).

"IV. CONSIDERING THAT THE ELIMINATION OF DUPLICATE FLIGHT NUMBERS IN NO WAY AFFECTS THE FREEDOM OF THE COMPANY TO CARRY OUT ITS SERVICES, AND THAT, ON THE CONTRARY, THE SAME FLIGHT NUMBER FOR DIFFERENT ITINERATIES OR THE SAME SERVICE WITH TWO DIFFERENT NUMBERS CAUSES ADMINISTRATIVE DIFFIKLTIES, WE COUNTON PAN AMERICAN'S GOOD WILL TO ELIMINATE THESE INCONVENIENCES, ESTABLISHING FOR EACH FLIGHT A NUMBER WHICH DEFINES AND INDIVIDUALIZES THE STOPS AND THE ROUTE."
