

THE COMMUNISTS IN UNICEF

There is one issue that concerns every American in regard to UNICEF. It is the Communists in UNICEF. The Communists are there. They are welcomed. Their presence is defended and the Communists receive help; and, most of all, it should be observed that they become great "humanitarians" as they join with free nations in helping children.

The two projects of UNICEF which reach the American people in the grass roots are:

1. Trick or Treat, collection at Halloween taken by the children of America, and
2. Greeting cards, especially at Christmas.

So much opposition to UNICEF has been raised that the United States Committee for UNICEF, United Nations, New York, has released a pamphlet, "UNICEF, Facts and Fallacies," to explain and justify UNICEF's program and to lead the American people to accept the presence of the Communists in UNICEF.

We now take this document produced by the official representatives of UNICEF, and use their own statements to demonstrate that their position is untenable and their program is unworthy of the support of liberty-loving Americans who would be interested in humanitarian aid for children. As Christians, we are first interested in presenting Jesus Christ and in helping the needy in Christ's name — not in the UN's name. UNICEF stands for United Nations Children's Fund (formerly United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund).

1. During Early UNICEF Emergency Operations, Communists Received Great Support

"UNICEF Facts" reports, "During the period of its emergency operation, from 1947 to 1950, UNICEF, in accordance with its mandate, concentrated . . . mainly in Europe." The report reads, "The following European countries received aid in this period: *Albania, Austria, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, Finland, France, Ger-*
