

against flesh and blood but against spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph. 6:10-17). God calls upon His people, having done all, to stand, and the basic conflict between Communism and Christianity is in the spiritual realm. All the hosts of hell have conspired to destroy Christianity, the Church of our Lord, and the freedom which God has given to His people to preach the Gospel.

Those who say, "Don't fight Communism, but preach the Gospel," are spiritually blinded, for without liberty the Gospel cannot be preached.

Jude 3:3—*"Beloved, when I gave all diligence, to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints."*

A Christianity which will not resist Communism is apostate! The so-called Christian forces which undermine "the will to resist," create the spirit of appeasement, call surrender to blackmail "humanitarianism," and demand the abolition of the security committees of the United States Government, are enemies of Christ and of our freedom and allies of the Communist world leaders.

A Christian resists Communism by the help of God. He believes that the Gospel of Jesus Christ includes this responsibility, and he looks to God for wisdom, courage, and grace. He believes in prayer and he appeals to God for deliverance. The Christian is and must be the most valiant warrior against godless Communism in the 20th century. The Communists have desired war — a cold war against the U.S.A. and the free West. The international Communist conspiracy is leading the fight to enslave the world. The Christian should lead the fight to win the cold war and he should do so in the name of the Lord of Hosts, the God of the armies of Israel.
