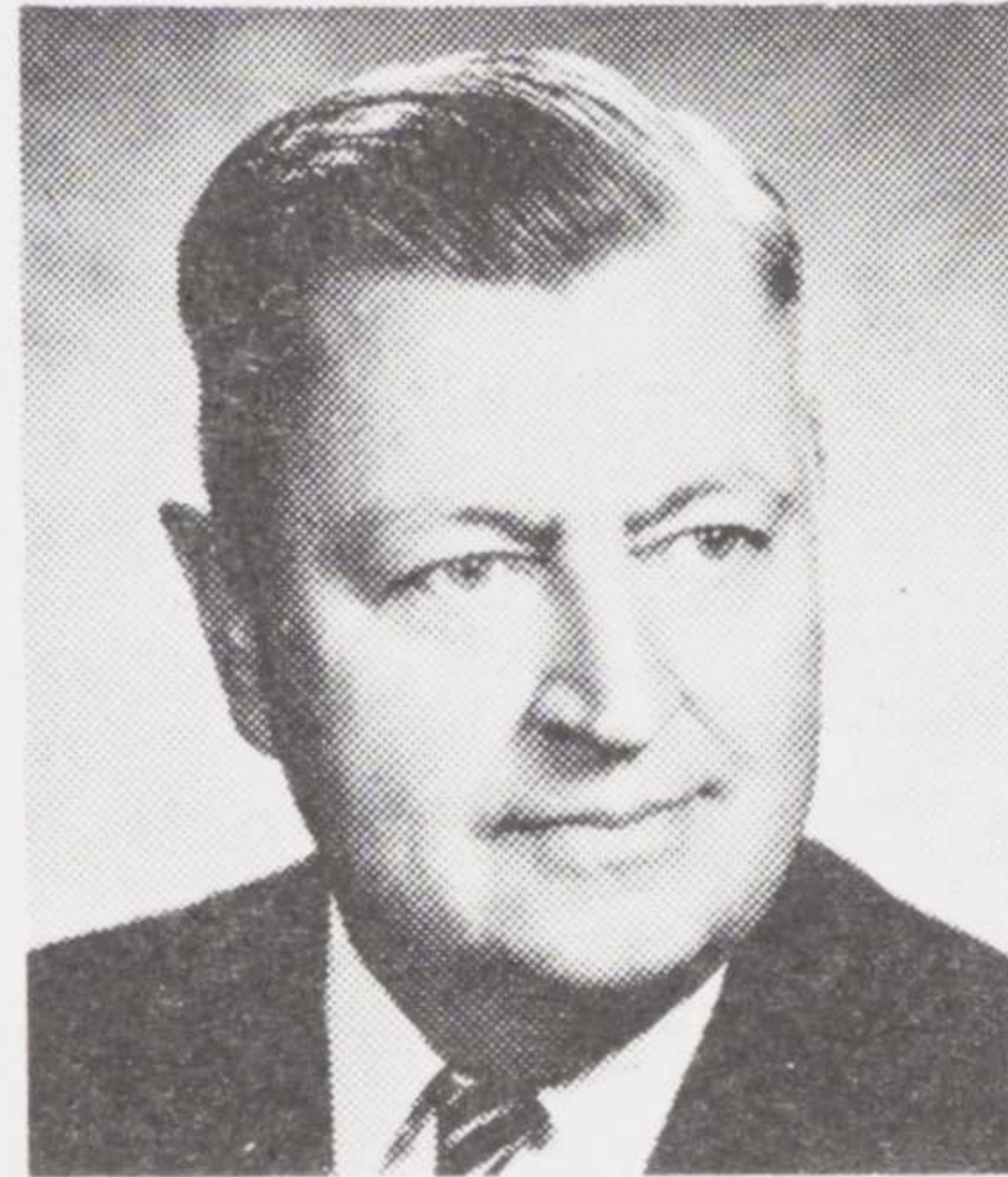
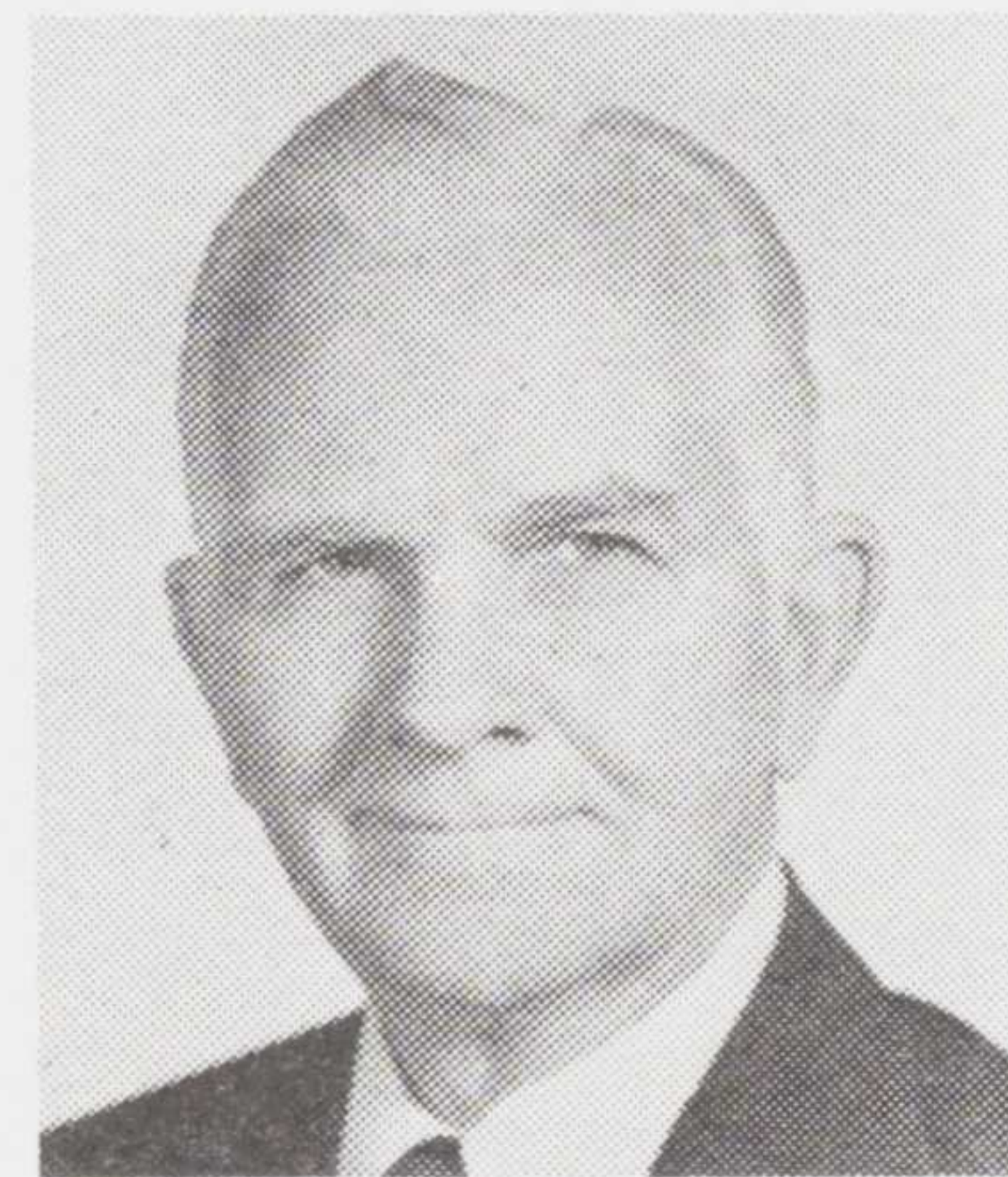

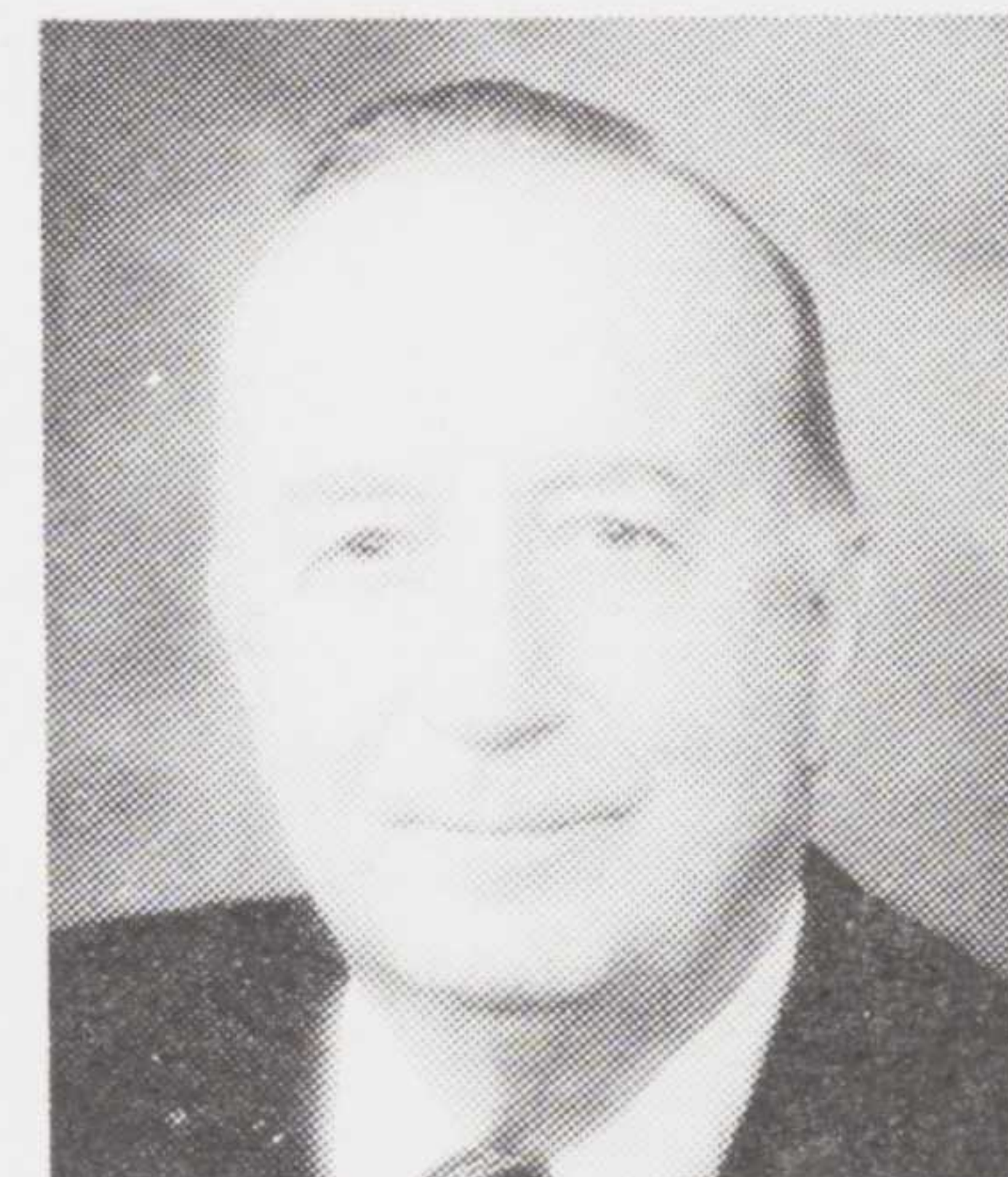

SINCE

its inception in 1948, the WCC has held world council meetings every 3 - 5 years. In 1954, the WCC held their conference in Evanston, Ill., where it hosted delegations from Communist countries.

In 1975, the WCC met in Nairobi, Kenya where it began its dialogue with the non-Christian religions. It established the Faith & Order Commission whose purpose is to explore what all religions in the world have in common theologically. Rather than upholding faith in Jesus Christ, one faith, one birth, one baptism, the WCC seeks to dilute all religions; unite them under one great ecumenical banner.

The International Council of Christian Churches, (ICCC) was established prior to the WCC in 1948. It has followed and opposed these developments throughout the years. It has sought to uphold the Christian faith. Now with 436 denominations as members throughout the world, the ICCC's 12th World Congress is a culmination of 40 years opposing unbelief, apostasy, atheistic Communism.
