

SOCIALIST PARTY OF ILLINOIS MINUTE

At its general meeting of July 8, the Socialist Party of Illinois passed the following minute:

"Bradford Lyttle, presidential candidate and organizer of the United States Pacifist Party was introduced and spoke on his campaign and the need for an end to nuclear deterrence policies. After questions and discussion the following motion was suggested by Erik Graff and moved by Abraham Bassford: The Socialist Party of Illinois finds nothing incompatible in the presidential campaign of Bradford Lyttle and the U.S. Pacifist Party with the platform of the Socialist Party of Illinois. Since we have no presidential candidate of our own, we commend its program to our members for their consideration. Approved."
