This ad, signed by Committee to save the Middle East from Communism, care of "California Jewish Voice", with a partial list of "Committee in Formation" signers, demands that the U.S.A. "must sell" arms to Israel, and "must cut off all financial, technical and military aid to Egypt and every Arab State that has joined the Kremlin-Cairo Pact." This ad has the nerve to repeat the bait used prior to World War II: "If the U.S.A. provides Israel with arms now, they shall not have to send American Armies there later."
.....That ad is but the beginning of a build-up to achieve World War III."
