A great many other theories of money and credit have been advanced and tried in practice since 1912, which marked the first German edition of *The Theory of Money and Credit* by Dr. Ludwig von Mises.

The inflation raging throughout the world today attests to the failure of those monetary theories that have most appealed to political demagogues intent upon the short run. The only thing these wasteful experiments have proved is the soundness of the theory advanced by Mises — proved that in the long run it will stand, though governments and politicians fail.

This is not a primer for casual reading. It is a study in depth for serious students of monetary theory.

Frederic Bastiat: A Man Alone

As a popular, though controversial, statesman, journalist, and author in nineteenth-century France, Frederic Bastiat helped formulate many of the ideas of laissez-faire capitalism, free trade, and economic individualism.

Especially noteworthy was Bastiat's pro-freedom role in the Revolutions of 1830 and 1848. And his address to the students of France is as important and timely today as it was in the Europe of his day.

In this biographical sketch of a brilliant man and of the politico-economic conditions he faced, Dr. Roche brings light to bear on many urgent problems of our time.

Seminars at the Foundation for Economic Education. In addition to lecturing at FEE and across the nation, Dr. Roche has written four other books: *Education in America*, *Power*, *American Federalism*, and *Legacy of Freedom*.
