Subject: Full Power authorizing Ellsworth Bunker to sign a Protocol of Amendment to the Charter of the Organization of American States

I enclose for the President's signature a Full Power authorizing Ellsworth Bunker, Ambassador at Large, to sign a Protocol of Amendment to the Charter of the Organization of American States at the Third Special Inter-American Conference which convened at Buenos Aires on February 15, 1967.

The sole item on the agenda for the Conference at Buenos Aires is consideration of the Protocol, which provides for comprehensive changes in the inter-American system. As presently drafted, a complete text having been circulated for advance review by the OAS Secretariat, the Protocol contains the draft amendment as prepared by a Special Commission which met in Panama February 24-April 1, 1966, and as revised by IA-ECOSOC in June 1966 with respect to the Economic and Social Standards.
