It was a pleasure to meet you and listen to your speech at the luncheon of the Pan American Society in New York last Tuesday.

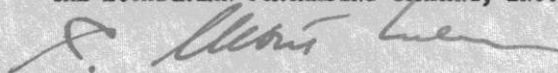
