QUOTE The opening of the John Fitzgerald Kennedy Memorial
housing project is the fulfilment of a dream not only for the

but for the man whose memory it honors.

John Fitzgerald Kennedy, early in his term as President,
envisioned a closer relationship between the peoples of the
Americas. He saw clearly the hopes and aspirations, not only of
his own people, but of the peoples of all the Americas. Holding this
ideal, he set in motion the idea of the Alliance for Progress which
today's ceremonies so vividly typify.

This housing project is more than just mortar and wood,
more than foundations and walls; it is a symbol of what free
