WHEN I DELIVERED PRESIDENT JOHNSON LETTER TO PRESIDENT CASTELLO BRANCO SUNDAY MORNING, HE NOTED REFERENCE DESIRE FOR FUTURE PERSONAL MEETING, AND ASKED WHETHER LETTER IMPLIED IMPOSSIBILITY LBJ VISIT DURING REMAINDER THIS YEAR. I SAID I UNDERSTOOD PRESIDENT HAD NOT ABANDONED IDEA OF VISIT, AND THAT IT WAS PREMATURE TO CONSIDER IT EXCLUDED DURING WHOLE OF 1965. BUT PROSPECTS SEEMZD VERY DIM AT LEAST FOR FIRST HALF OF YEAR. HE SAID HE FELT THWT THIS TIME PRIORITY WAS OF REAL SIGNIFICANCE IN US-LA RELATIONS GENERALLY, AND EXPRESSED STRONG HOPE THAT WHENEVER PRESIDENT JOHNSON FELT FREE TO TRAVEL OUTSIDE US, HE WOULD STILL MAKE LATIN March 30, 1965 AMERICA FIRST POINT OF CALL.
