b. Subparagraph 5, add the following to information on travel:

October 1957, visited son who was stationed in Miami, Florida.

13 October 1959, assigned to be Representative of the Brazilian government at the 10th Session of the United Nations Organization for Food and Agriculture (FAO), to be held in Rome, Italy, November 1959. Rio daily press on 13 Oct 1959 stated assignment of subject officer by President KUBITSCHER was political; Brazil was not aware of the merits of this officer on the subjects of food and agriculture; subject officer's knowledge in these matters was debatable.

6 July 1960, participated in inaugural flight of VARIG's Boeing 707 from Brasilia to New York.

8-17 June 1964, BAF representative at the Symposium on Strategic Information in Panama.

March 1960 - Feb 1961 1st Subchief of AF General Staff, Rio.

Sept 1961 - Mar 1963 Director General of Civil Aeronautics, Rio.

(Note: 19 Sep 1961, Rio daily press complained about the return of subject officer to the Directorate of Civil Aeronautics. Article stated the most expressive obstacles civil aviation in Brazil encountered were the intentional omissions and attitude of subject officer as Director General of Civil Aeronautics. The article further stated that the situation had become so bad in commercial aviation Congress had to conduct an investigation in order to study the situation; the investigation is recorded in the records of the House of Representatives; it would certainly behoove the present government to look at this investigation before it had decided to appoint subject officer to the position of Director General of Civil Aeronautics-- a decision which they might regret.)

30 Jun 1964 - 17 July 1964 Add'l Duty: Assigned to be in charge of a Military Police investigation of BAF officers accused of subversive activities.
