
BIOGRAPHIC SKETCH

He has a background in intelligence and personnel and, prior to his present assignment, served as Director of the Directorate of Personnel Administration (1978-1979). He was the Air Attache to Italy from 1973-1975. He was enrolled in a Flight Safety Officers Course at an unidentified US training school.
