(C) Labor In first cabinet meeting, Labor Minister JARBAS PASSARINHO stated that the only way to combat communist and subversive influence in the labor movement was to admit where the government had erred and to publicly admit it. In other words, to seize the initiative by admitting the shortcomings of policy. He said "before I am through, some people will say I am a communist sympathizer."
- 4. (C) Future Plans of Presidents Son Col. (Ret) ALCIO COSTA E SILVA told RO that his father wanted him to move to Brasilia to serve as his personal secretary.
